Note: As per the decision of UG Medical Education Board of NMC:

- 1. There would not be a separate dedicated month for the Foundation Course.
- 2. All the elements of Foundation Course shall be carried out by allotting additional hour using the Saturdays/Holidays.
- 3. The elements of the Foundation Course should be completed during the first 4-5 months of the I MBBS course in logical sequence.
- 4. Foundation Course is compulsory and an attendance of 75% will be mandatory
- 5. The contributing department should prepare the lesson plan using the **Module of the Foundation Course** issued from NMC and communicate the same to the Phase wise curriculum sub-committees well in advance which in turn forward the same to the MEU coordinator and the Dean & Chairman of the curriculum committee.
- 6. The curricular sub-committee of the Phase-I & II should coordinate with the respective departments for the smooth conduction of the course elements. For any doubts and queries you can contact with MEU Co-ordinator.
